This will serve as the platform for acquiring state-of-the-art knowledge and skills in power and automation technologies by critical staff in the industry.

As we formally sign this document to establish the new strategic partnership between our organisations, I look forward to fully exploring the opportunities that this new relationship with ABB will offer. This is because our partnership now goes beyond purchasing and supply of goods and services; to breaking new frontiers in research, manufacturing, consultancy and improved productivity and performance, to the mutual benefit of our two organizations.
